The ministry of Altar Server is to assist at Holy Mass and at other liturgical celebrations (weddings, benediction, vespers, etc.).

The Altar Server function is a very important and honored role. In assisting the Priest or Deacon, the Altar Server is in a very special way, helping to offer the sacrifice of the Mass. This includes several tasks such as, cross bearer, candle bearer, incense bearer, and other tasks. On special occasions, such as the Sacrament of Confirmation, the Bishop is assisted by Altar Servers, which is a very special honor.

THE COMMITMENT

- ◆ To serve as scheduled or find a replacement - this can be easily done by logging into Ministry Scheduler website and logging into your account. - “No Shows” disrespect the Liturgy.
- ◆ Dress properly (i. e. no tennis shoes or sneakers)
- ◆ Arrive 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the Liturgy.
- ◆ Encourage and assist other servers as needed.
- ◆ Set an example for the entire congregation by participating in the Eucharist.
- ◆ Hang up cassock and surplice at the conclusion of the Liturgy.
