THE COMMITMENT

- ✦ To serve as scheduled or to find a replacement - "NO SHOWS" disrespect the Liturgy.
- ✦ Dress properly (i.e. no tennis shoes or sneakers).
- ✦ Arrive 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the Liturgy.
- ✦ Encourage and assist other servers as needed.
- ✦ Set an example for the entire congregation by participating in the Eucharist.
- ✦ Hang up your cassock and surplice at the conclusion of the Liturgy.
