

INTERNET RELIGIOUS EDUCATION-7th GRADE

Each student needs to be registered in the program.

A family needs to have internet access at home or it will be difficult for to fully participate in the program.

You will be provided:

- Student's books (2)
- Instructions for the internet
- It is recommended that you start with *Jesus in the New Testament* and then *do Mystery of God*. These align the closest to the actual classroom curriculum and should your child be able to reenter the traditional class, the transition will be easier and not create a duplication.

Note: If you are not getting an email at least once quarterly, it means we do not have a current email address. Please send an email asking us to add your family to the distribution list. We will use the address of your email shown in the "From" line of the message unless you otherwise instruct us.

The internet option for 7th Grade can only be used with the permission of the Director of Religious Education.

Each book contains 12 lessons only and does not include lessons for Advent, Lent, Christmas, etc. Completing these 24 lesson weeks will enable a 7th Grader to go on to the 8th grade. The teen should do a minimum of one lesson each week in the student book until all 24 are completed. It is alright to do multiple lessons and complete early.
